

Theme: Whole-of-Nation implementation, Innovation, and Acceleration


# 2022 VNR process flow




# Dropout Rate or School Leavers Rate






# Coverage of protected areas in relation to marine areas






# Number of reported gender-based violence cases (includes e- VAW)

# **Innovations for Health and Resiliency**

#### **Pandemic Response Playbook**

• A guide for government policies and for non-government stakeholders' contribution in the event that another surge of COVID-19 cases occurs again in the future

#### **Public-Private Task Force T3 (Test, Trace, and Treat)**

 Involves private companies and volunteer executive teams who are working with the national and local government in COVID-19 response and management

# FASSSTER (Feasibility Analysis of Syndromic Surveillance Using Spatio-Temporal Epidemiological Modeler for Early Detection of Diseases)

 A disease surveillance tool that models disease spreads by Integrating localized indices from Philippine health records and other data sources



















# Innovations for the Economy

#### **Digital payments**

Development and improvement of retail e-payment instruments and streamlining of account ownership have been pivotal in allowing financially unserved and underserved sectors to avail of opportunities for recovery and growth

#### **Digital banks**

 Establishment of digital banks is expected to contribute to greater efficiency in the delivery of financial products and services, and in expanding reach to the unbanked market segments

#### **Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT)**

• Can promptly and safely receive salaries, pensions, social security benefits, and other types of financial assistance



# **Innovations for Social**

#### Provision of IT gadgets

- Field visits were conducted to distribute educational tools, including smartphones, tablets, and laptops, to schools, learners, and personnel in 2021
- Last-mile schools or schools that have multi-grade classes, with less than five teachers, a student population of less than 100 learners, and where more than 75 percent of which are indigenous people, were given special attention to ensure that no one is left behind
- LGUs also partnered with DepEd to provide tablets for the school in their scope of locality

#### City of Manila

Distribution of tablets and sim cards to students, and laptops for teachers in public schools

#### **Quezon City**

Provision of gadgets for blended learning was institutionalized (Ordinance No. SP-2954)

Free use of tablets to all secondary public school students in preparation for blended learning for the school year 2020-2021

#### **Urban Carrying Capacity Assessments (UCCA)**




# Key interactions of SDG 3.3 Fighting communicable diseases













## Financing plan and effective resource mobilization

- Development of a Program Convergence Budgeting Framework and Guidelines
- Implementation of tax reforms such as the Sin Tax Law which mandates that 20 percent of the revenue goes to funding SDG programs



## **Robust monitoring system**

- Review of SDG indicators to ensure that the country's performance is meaningful to Filipinos
- The SDG Watch that is being compiled by the PSA will be complemented by the Community-Based Monitoring System which will provide more granular data at the household level



## Ownership of the SDGs at the national and local level

- Integration of the SDGs into the Philippines' national, sub-national, and local governance mechanisms through its Sub-Committee on Sustainable Development Goals (SC-SDG)
- Localization of the assessment and planning of SDG indicators to better identify the gaps in SDG implementation
