<p><i>Section VII. Technical Specification Page 28</i></p> <p>Print Speed: 45ppm A4</p>	<p><i>Question: Can we relax the requirement for 45ppm to at least 40ppm or 43ppm for A4?</i></p> <p><i>Answer: Print Speed: 43ppm A4</i></p>
<p><i>Section VII. Technical Specification Page 28</i></p> <p>Toner Capacity: 12,000 pages or higher with two (2) additional higher capacity toner cartridge</p>	<p><i>Question: Can we omit the requirement on toner capacity? Or, can we change the requirement to “at least 6,000 pages” and instead of “two (2) additional cartridges”, only “one (1) additional higher capacity toner cartridge”</i></p> <p><i>Answer: No changes will be made in the requirements. Also, we need to have a buffer stock for the toners so the requirement for additional cartridges will not be changed.</i></p>
<p><i>Section VII. Technical Specification Page 28</i></p> <p>Standard Memory: 512 MB</p>	<p><i>Question: Can we change the requirement to “at least standard memory of 256 MB”?</i></p> <p><i>Answer: No changes will be made in the requirements.</i></p>

Technical Specification Page 28</i></p> <p>Paper Trays Standard Input: 500 - sheets input tray 2,600 - sheets maximum input capacity incl. options</p>	<p><i>Question: Since the requirement is “optional”, can the “manufacturer standard” be omitted?</i></p> <p><i>Answer: We retain the requirement for paper trays standard input. Kindly suggest maximum input tray capacity for your product being offered.</i></p>

Technical Specification Page 30</i></p> <p>Toner Capacity: 2,200 pages (CMY), 2,600 pages (K) or higher</p> <p>With additional higher capacity black (K) toner cartridge</p>	<p><i>Question: Can we relax the yield requirement since we carry different brand that has a different yield capacity? From 2,200 pages (CMY) to 2,100 pages (CMY) and from 2,600 pages (K) to 2,400 pages (K)? Or, from 2,200 pages (CMY) to 1,500 pages (CMY) and from 2,600 pages (K) to 1,500 pages (K), without additional higher capacity black (K) toner cartridge?</i></p> <p><i>Answer: No changes will be made in the requirements. Also, we need to have a buffer stock for the toners so the requirement for additional cartridges will not be changed.</i></p>

Technical Specification Page 30</i></p> <p>Paper Trays Standard Input: 250 - sheets input tray 550 - sheets maximum input capacity with options 50 - sheets multipurpose tray</p>	<p><i>Question: Since the requirement is "optional", can the "manufacturer standard" be omitted?</i></p> <p><i>Answer: We retain the requirement for paper trays standard input. Kindly suggest maximum input tray capacity for your product being offered.</i></p>
<p><i>Section VII. Technical Specification Page 30</i></p> <p>Paper Trays Standard Output: 150 - sheets face down</p>	<p><i>Question: Instead of 150 sheets face down, can we offer at least 100 sheets facedown?</i></p> <p><i>Answer: We retain the requirement.</i></p>
