Furthermore, overtime/extra services under Item VI. shall be billed separately.

Section VIII. Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents	Question: Is the AFS 2023 required to be the one declared in PhilGEPS Certificate and not 2022?
Page 49	Answer: Our requirement is a valid PhilGEPS Platinum Membership Registration Certificate. Submission of Audited Financial Statement is not required as attachment to the Certificate.
	Question: During the post-qualification, a certified true copy of the permits and licenses declared in the PhilGEPS certificate may be presented, does this mean we need to get the certified true copy from the local agency or national agency where we registered or received [these] permits and licenses? Or is it okay for it to be certified by our authorized representatives?
	Answer: During the post-qualification process, we only require submission of latest income and business tax returns filed and paid through the BIR Electronic Filing and Payment System (eFPS) and the documents required stated under the ITB Clause 20.1 of the Bid Documents or as stated in the above amendment. We may request the bidders to present the original documents for verification and validation.
	Question: Regarding the declaration of all ongoing contract, specifically the "amount of contract", are you pertaining to the amount declared in the contract in an annual value or the value representing the whole contract duration?
	Answer: The amount of contract being contemplated in the requirement is the whole contract price.
	Question: Regarding the declaration of all ongoing contract, specifically the "value of outstanding contract", is it acceptable if we based our computation on the actual latest billing or the latest PO for the project or the Contract Change Request reflecting the new amount of contract? This is because there may have a lot of changes in the contract due to increase of mandatory government contributions, additional manpower or decrease of manpower requested by the client, increase in consumables, and other reason as well.
	Answer: Please compute the value of the outstanding contract based on the contract price of the signed contract.
	Question: For the SLCC, can we provide a contract that has an integrated facilities management scope of work, which means other services are included such as pest control, landscaping, technical services, etc. but as long as janitorial services are equivalent to 50% of the ABC?
	Answer: Yes, you may.
	Question: During the post-qualification, a certified true copy of the SLCC contract may be presented, do you accept the one certified by the bidder's authorized representative or you preferred it to be certified by the client's authorized representative? Or both parties?

Answer: During the post-qualification process, we only require submission of latest income and business tax returns filed and paid through the BIR Electronic

Filing and Payment System (eFPS) and the documents required stated under the ITB Clause 20.1 of the Bid Documents or as stated in the above amendment.

We may request the bidders to present the original documents for verification and validation.

Provisions in the bidding documents that are in conflict with this Bulletin are deemed revised/amended. For guidance and information of all concerned.
